May Allah SWT grant all students success in this life and the hereafter.


















KINDERGARTEN'S FIRST ZOO ADVENTURE

IFTAAR NIGHTS AT WGS







MEET THE TEACHER (PRIMARY)

Parents enjoyed socialising afterward with the classroom teachers as they got to casually discuss their child's engagement at school. This event marked an important partnership with our parent community.






LETS HEAR FROM THE _____ 2019 ALUMNI STUDENTS
